



CASTLES OF VOJVODINA

Castles in Vojvodina were built in the period between the 18th and 20th century. They were built by rich farmers and the Austro-Hungarian nobility, usually far from cities. They are almost always surrounded by large parks and horse farms. From thirty castles in Vojvodina, only three are included in the tourist offer: castle in Kulpin , castle in Ečka and Fantast in Becej.



Program:

Departure from Belgrade at 08:00 from parking in front of the hotel Intercontinental. Arrival in Becej and sightseeing of the Serbian Orthodox Church with 63 icons made by Uroš Predić.

In the middle of fields, like a white petrified shell, The Castle Fantast is located, which was made and owned by famous lord Bogdan Dunđerski. Look like the French palaces, castle was built between 1919 and 1923 , and represents a wonderful mixture of different styles, with four towers and main tower. In addition to the castle there is a small chapel, where Dunđerski was buried. Chapel was painted by the renowned Serbian painter Uroš Predić.

Continuing the trip to the Carska Bara - Nature Reserve at about 1600 ha, which is characterized by a large number of canals, lakes and ponds. The flora is a real imperial oasis. World fame of this area is based on the presence of many rare birds (about 240 species). There you can find eight European species of heron, and this bird is selected as a sign of this reserve. Boat ride on the lake.

Going to Ečka and visit the castle of Earl Lazar Lukac and church from the 1711 year. The castle was once residence of Earl Esterhazi, and today here is located art colony with over 2000 pictures. Late lunch in the castle.
